Title: *Dirty Mr. Orlando and the Murky Trap*

Type: Suspenseful & Humorous Narrative Video

Duration: 4–6 minutes

Source: Provided story excerpt

Purpose: To create a dramatized narrative video using provided visuals and voiceovers

SCENE BREAKDOWN & EDITING INSTRUCTIONS

Scene 1 – The Night Knock

- Setting: Nighttime atmosphere
 - Sound: Door knock, soft suspenseful background tone
 - Actions: Officer knocks, the door opens immediately
 - Dialogue (in sync with visuals):
 - “Officer, Orlando has turned golden. Something is not right I swear!”
 - “I sensed someone inside the house when father was not there!”
 - “Someone inside the house?”
 - Maintain a tone of curiosity and mild fear

Scene 2 – The Strange Song

- Add faint singing sound from a distance
- “Is someone singing?”
- “Dirty is singing a song, praying to God for help??”

- “He doesn’t believe in God.”
 - Insert audio of the tragic song:
“Please God save me. Let me not reach the Moon! I will believe in you forever and ever, let me not reach the Moon!”
 - “What kind of lyrics are these, let me not reach the Moon?”
 - Keep balance of suspense and humor

Scene 3 – Outside the Door

- Sound: gentle knocking on door
 - “Dad, this is me, Anna. Are you alright?”
 - “Go away and let me sleep! Do not ever come to my house!”
 - Add sudden “thud” sound effect
 - “Dad, did someone hit you?”
 - “I am fine, go away!”
 - End scene with a short pause and low background hum

Scene 4 – The Awakening

- Transition to early morning ambience (around 4 AM)
- “Wake up boy!”
- “It is only 4 am. Please let me sleep.”
- “I have got food for you. Let us eat it.”
- “That’s great! Where is it?”
- “I put it in the courtyard.”

- “You should have got it in. Wait, I’ll get it.”
 - Sound: balcony door opens and shuts
 - Sudden screams: “Leave me! Help! Anna!”

Scene 5 – The Alligator Chaos

- Add layers of yelling, neighbour voices, and confusion
 - “Cut his shorts!”
 - “They stink... eee!”
 - “What is Mr. Dirty doing with an alligator?”
 - “Goodly!”
 - “Let us take a piece of him for your poet.”
 - “Poets do not eat alligators!”
 - Keep editing fast-paced with overlapping sounds of chaos
-

Scene 6 – The Rescue and Climax

- Add siren sound (patrolling team arrives)
- “He will eat you alive!”
- Include struggle sounds and crowd shouting
- Alligator faints holding the shorts
- Short pause after chaos
- Final line: “Orlando’s odour was indeed a bio weapon.”
- End with either a brief musical cue or ironic silence.
